Camping-Ground Rules

Dear Camping Guest,

the administration of this camping-ground bids you a hearty welcome, wishing that you may enjoy a restful stay. We are making every effort to render the time you are going to pass here as agreeable to you as possible. In the interest of all camping guests present here, you are kindly requested to avoid everthing that might disturb their community. Therefore, be so good as to observe the following camping rules:

1. Access to the camping-ground is permitted only after previous information and on submitting the camping-ground certificate. Therefore, the camping guest or visitor will first inform the „reception“ of his arrival. According to the official regulations in force, the groundsman is empowered to inspect the identity cards of every camping guest and visitor. Prior to finally leaving the ground, the camping guest informs the „reception“ of his forthcoming departure.
2. The camping guest or visitor pays the usage fees fixed for this camping-ground, according to the schedule of charges listed in the accompanying notice. Members of specified German or International Camping Organizations will be allowed reductions upon presentation of the necessary certificates.
3. Order and cleanness are a matter of course for all users of the camping-ground. Pleasure-grounds and installations should be treated with care. It is forbidden to tear off branches and bougths from trees and hedges.
4. The instructions given by the administration or the groundsman should be fully complied with, particularly as regards the parking of motor vehicles and caravans and the pitching of tents and the like.
5. Dogs of whatever size should always be kept on a lead.
6. It is not allowed to enclose standing-places with ditches and fences. See to it that nobody will ever be endangered or inconvenienced by tent pegs, tent cords and other tent accessories.
7. Refuse of any kind is supposed to be put in the pertinent garbage cans.
8. For open fires use only the place especially marked out for that purpose. Open fires should be extinguished at 22.00 hours, at the latest.
9. Quiet should prevail on the ground from 13 to 15 and 22 to 7 hours. During this time, vehicles are not allowed to travel on the camping-ground. Wireless sets, record players and similar devices should be set to tent sound volume. We kindly request in the interest of all guests to also avoid any loud talking during the aforesaid time. Whoever grossly violates these rules should not be surprised to be sent off that ground immediately.
10. Noise constituting a nuisance should also be avoided at day-time.
11. Cycling and autocycling as well as playing football on the ground are felt to be troublesome to most guests and therefore not allowed.
12. Vehicles of any kind are allowed to travel at walking speed only on those ways which are intended for that purpose.
13. Prior to his departure, the camping guest should put his camp completely in order.
14. Tramps are not allowed to enter the camping-ground. The practice of a trade carried on in the camping-ground or starting from the latter, as well as shows, are subject to authorization by the administration.
15. In the exercise of their domestic authority, the administration or the groundsman are entitled to refuse persons or to send them off the ground if such measures seem to be necessary to maintain order on the camping-ground or serve the interest of the camping guests.
